

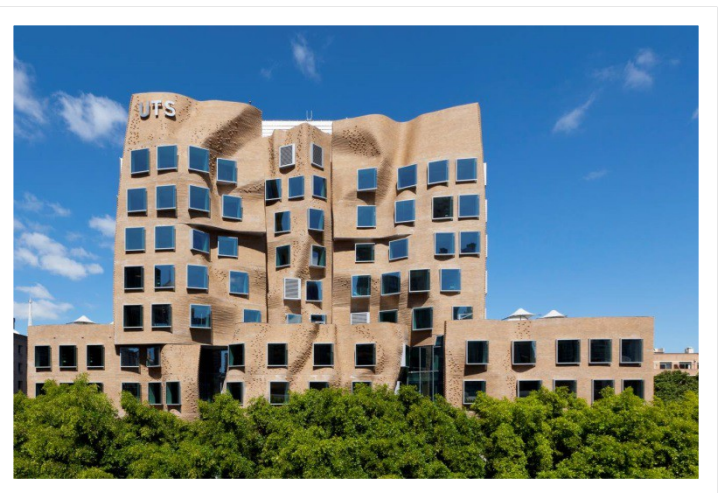
Statistics in Stiletto^{**}
